120 odor and corrosion control projects around the world for treatment plants, pump stations, large diameter sewers, collections systems, and biosolids processing facilities. He has also authored numerous articles and publications on the subject of municipal odor and corrosion control. A Texas registered professional engineer, Jim has a bachelor's degree in civil engineering and a master's degree in environmental engineering. He is an active member in the Water Environment Association of Texas and the Water Environment Federation.


