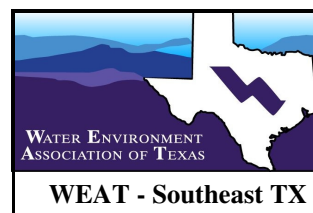
The new WEAT officers will be meeting early this summer to determine dates and topics for the next the season. We will inform everyone of these dates as soon as possible.

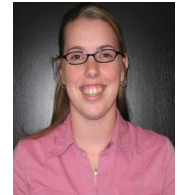

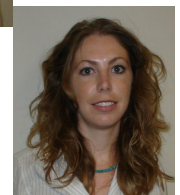
