

Dr. Sunil Kommineni presented an educational and interactive lecture on "Application of Membranes for Water/ Wastewater Treatment" which served as a great prequel to the upcoming SJRA Surface Water Treatment Plant Tour. During the informative session, Dr. Kommineni spoke about ultrafiltration and microfiltration membranes, design criteria, operational advantages and challenges and manufacturers of membranes. The seminar lecture held at the HESS Club was attended by 30 professionals from the Houston area.
